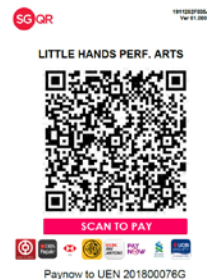

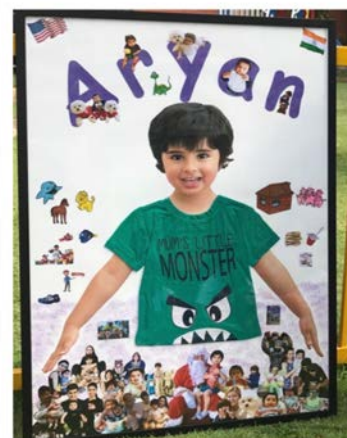
Little Hands Montessori 2023

Storytelling - The Lost Art

There is a concern that in this day and age with so many electronics, people are losing the art of communication and the ability to build personal relationships. Major corporates are sending their senior executives to storytelling training, to relearn how to connect with people and make a memorable and positive impression on them.

The aboriginal people have no written language so rely on storytelling through painting, song and dance to share their history with others. During this camp each child will put together a collage using different visual art mediums depicting who they are, the world around them, their likes, loves and passions. This piece of art will tell their story.

Ways to tell stories...

Painting, Drawing, building, photos, collage, games.

Telling - both spoken and singing.

Doing - actions (mime), acting, facial expressions.

How we dress and look, dress ups.

Dancing.

Storytelling through toys, dolls and puppets.

Answering questions.

We will touch on all these during the camp.
